Answer questions



Have tests of blood, saliva, stool or urine



Have simple check-ups or exams



Send blood to be stored for later research



Have X-rays and other kinds of body scans



You can decide to do some or all of these, or some parts of each.



It is up to you to decide if you should be in the study or not, and if you want to sign the consent form.



Possible risks may include:

Loss of private information



Discomfort from blood tests and check-ups



Radiation from CT scan (for some people)



You can stop being in the study at any time.
